COVID-19 UPDATE

NSW Parts of Penrith added to the Hotspots list

The LGAs of Concern have been joined by a series of suburbs from the Penrith LGA.

From **5pm Sunday 8th August**, the specific suburbs listed below, not the whole Penrith LGA, are subject to the tighter restrictions;

Caddens, Claremont Meadows, Colyton, Erskine Park, Kemps Creek, Kingswood, Mount Vernon, North St Marys, Orchard Hills, Oxley Park, St Clair, St Marys

Settings;

- Stay at home – leaving only for essential work/school, food, medical care and vaccination
- May leave home for essential work, but may not leave the LGA unless the employee is an authorised worker
- May not leave the LGA (other than authorised worker as above)
- 5km radius applies to movements
- Masks required indoors (not in the home) and outdoors

While it is possible for essential workers (such as fuel retail and wholesale staff) to move in and out of these areas for essential work, as with the other Hotspots, it is recommended that businesses review rosters and staffing and minimise movement in and out of these areas of concern if possible.

NSW Armidale Region Lockdown

The **Armidale region** is in lockdown until **12am Sunday 15 August** and the Hunter and Newcastle region until **11:59pm on Thursday 12 August** and the settings to apply are “those that apply to Greater Sydney”. Surveillance testing requirements will not apply to these particular lockdowns.

NSW Tamworth LGA

TAMWORTH LGA ADDED TO AREAS OF CONCERN LIST, RESTRICTIONS IN PLACE FROM 5PM

From **5pm 9th August 2021**, increased restrictions apply to people who live in or are temporarily staying in the **Tamworth** local government area. The restrictions will be in place until **12.01am Tuesday 16th August** and apply to all people who live in the area or have been there on or after 5 August.

The only reason to leave your home during this period for one of the five reasons: **sourcing essential supplies, authorised work or education, care and caregiving, exercise and to get vaccinated**

QLD

Cairns and Yarrabah into Lockdown

The regions of **Cairns and Yarrabah** are subject to a 3 day lockdown from **4pm 8th August 2021**.

Settings;

- Stay at home – leaving only for essential work/school, food, exercise, medical care and vaccination
- 10km radius applies to movements
- Masks required indoors (not in the home) in the workplace, and when in contact (within 1.5m) of other people

QLD

South East Queensland Lockdown Lifts

The lockdown in **South East QLD** lifted **4pm Sunday 8th August** as planned, but some restrictions will remain for the next two weeks.

Settings;

- Masks remain mandated indoor and outdoor (unless isolated)
- 1 person per 4sqm
- Up to 10 visitors in the home
- No community sport

REGIONAL VICTORIA

Exits Lockdown From Midnight

This morning the Victorian Government has announced that regional Victoria will exit lockdown at 11.59pm Monday 9th August. Restrictions will stay the same in Metropolitan Melbourne.

The five reasons to leave home will no longer apply in regional Victoria.

- There is no limit on the distance regional Victorians can travel from home.
- Travel to Melbourne is possible only for the permitted reasons (i.e. work if it cannot be done remotely) and Melbourne restrictions will need to be followed for the duration.
- Restaurants and cafes are permitted to reopen with seated service with a cap of 100 people, subject to the density quotient of 1 person per 4 sqm. Venues smaller than 100sqm can have up to 25 people before density requirements apply.
- Retail can reopen with a density cap of 1 person per 4 sqm. Beauty services can resume where a mask can be worn. Face masks can be removed where required for beauty services.
- Offices can return with a 25 per cent cap, or a cap of 10 people, whichever is greater. However, if you can work from home, you should.
- **Businesses that are open in regional Victoria but closed in Melbourne** - restaurants for dine-in service or beauty, for example - must check the IDs of everyone they serve.
- The use of the Victoria Service App QR codes remains mandatory.

Face masks **must be worn indoors and outdoors, except in the home.**

Note: Cleaning, signage, record keeping, and other COVIDSafe requirements continue to apply for all venues and facilities with onsite operations as per Workplace Directions. The Density Quotient (DQ) applies to all venues and spaces that are accessible to the public (and in closed workplaces, to shared spaces such as lunchrooms).
